

Assistant Coach Stingrays

The Stingrays are looking for a part-time Assistant Swim Coach with a love of swimming and at least one year of competitive swimming or coaching experience. The Assistant Swim Coach will collaborate with the Head Coach and work with our youth swim team. Coaches will welcome and encourage youth to improve all-around swimming ability, including technique, strength, conditioning and safety. The position requires Monday-Thursday evening practices from late March to early June and then morning/early afternoon practices from early June to the end of July. Swim meets are Saturdays June to the end of July.

Responsibilities:

- Teach the proper skills and techniques of swimming.
- Ensure the safety of swimmers which includes incident prevention, response and reporting.
- Write workouts including drills, and coach with positivity and enthusiasm.
- Enforce club rules and pool rules while providing a high level of customer service to members and their guests.

- Must have at least one year of competitive swimming or coaching experience.
- Knowledge and ability to teach all ages the proper skill and techniques of swimming,
- Enthusiastic, responsible, self-motivated and team oriented.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Ability to demonstrate motivation and patience with children of all ages.
- Current American Red Cross Lifeguard certification preferred.
- Ability to pass background check.
