



Co-Head Coach with the Campolindo Cabana Club Swim Team (Moraga, CA)

The Campolindo Cabana Club (CCC) Swim team is seeking a Co-Head Coach for the 2022-23 swim season. The age groups would include 11-18 year old recreational swimmers. The CCC Swim Team is located in Moraga and is part of the Orinda Moraga Pool Association, one of the premier recreational swim leagues in California. This community based team was established in 1968. The team currently has 160+ members, along with an additional 40 children that participate in our Learn to Swim program and Mini Marlins Program.

CCC traditionally runs a Spring Swim program (March 1 –April 30), a regular season program (May 1- early August, and a Fall Spring program (September and October). From June 1 to August 1, practices are held in the morning and for the other programs, in the afternoons. Swim meets are traditionally held on Wednesday nights and Saturday mornings.

The ideal candidate will have a competitive swimming background, understands and is able to convey to the swimmers, proper stroke technique, starts, turns, etc. We are also in search of a leader that has a passion for the sport of swim, but will also help our young swimmers to learn about work ethic, teamwork, sportsmanship, striving to improve and most importantly to have fun!

The candidate will be able to:

- Attend all swim meets, practices and many of the social events
- Work in conjunction with the 6-10 year old Co-Head Coach to develop cohesive practice plans for all age groups
- Serve as a leader/mentor for the Assistant Coaches to help develop their coaching skills and training methods
- In conjunction with the 6-10 Year old Co-Head Coach, develop work schedule for assistant coaches
- Develop swim meet line-up with assuring line up entries are made in a timely manner
- Provide feedback for swimmers during meets
- Attend team building and social events as needed
- In conjunction with the 6-10 Year old Co-Head Coach, send weekly communication to the team parents
- Respond to any parent inquiries in a timely manner
- Communicate with the CCC Board of Directors throughout the season and attend Board Meetings as needed
