

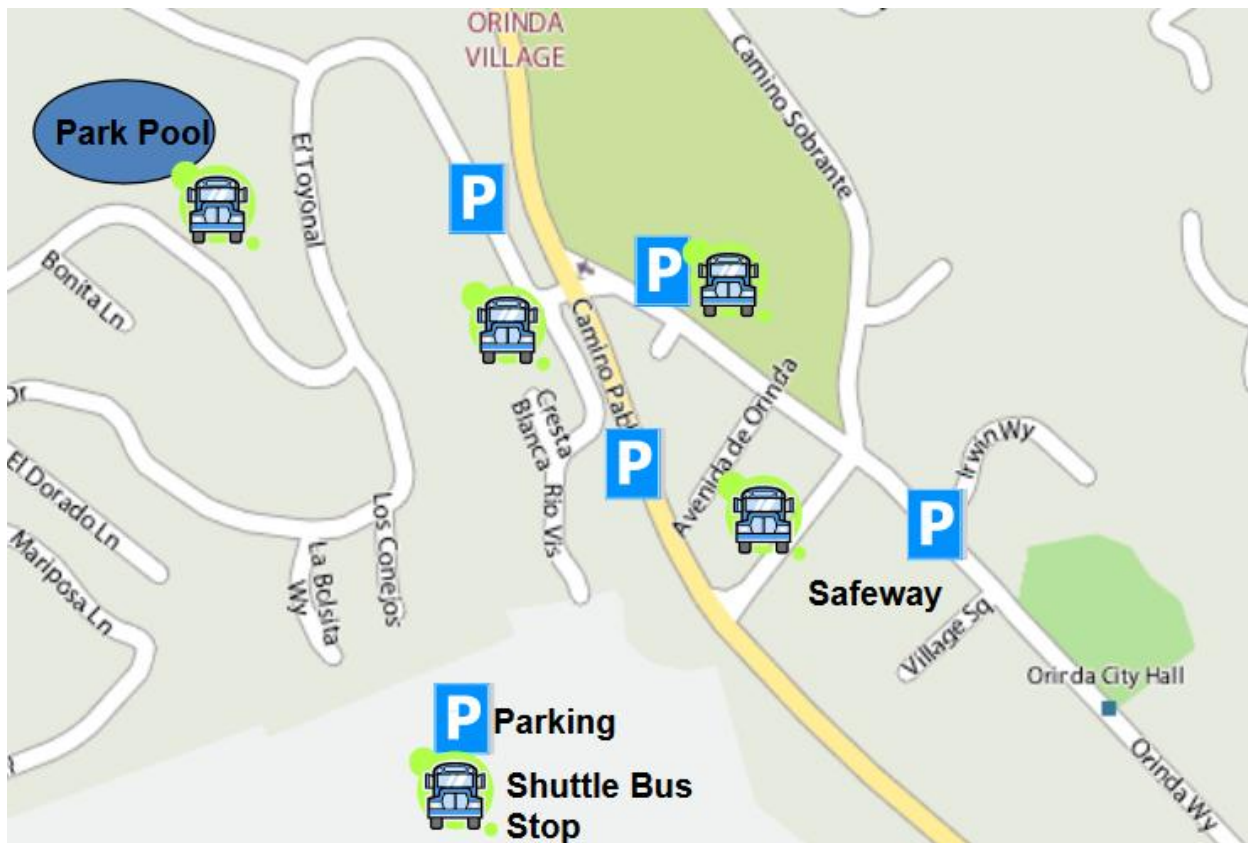


## 2026 ORINDA PARK POOL (OPP) RELAYS PARKING INFORMATION

Dear OPP Relays Participants,

Ticketing and towing illegally parked cars in all areas near the pool is now more aggressive than ever. In fact, there are no longer warnings given prior to the ticketing or towing of a car. If a car is parked in a manner that another car needs to cross the center line to get around it, despite the size of the car, **IT WILL BE TOWED!** Because of this, an additional effort has been made to provide ample parking (see list below). There will be 8 to 10 shuttles running throughout the meet and for one hour following the last event to transport people to/from shuttle bus stops to/from the pool. We ask that swimmers be dropped off at the pool with their belongings, prior to parking, to keep things moving as efficiently as possible.

**Please carpool, if possible.** We want this meet to be filled with fun and laughter, not the frustration and annoyance that can result from ticketing and towing.





**Available Parking with Shuttle Pick up:**

- Bottom of El Toyonal (right side only) –curb your wheels!
- Camino Pablo –between Orinda Way and Camino Sobrante (in front of Safeway).
- Citibank Parking Lot – located at the intersection of Irwin Way and Orinda Way next to Safeway. Do not park in the Safeway parking lot.
- **Both sides of Orinda Way-the two-hour maximum has been waived until 2:00pm.**

**Off-limits Parking with Risk of Ticketing and Towing:**

- **There is no parking for any reason during drop-off.** This is an extremely busy time in our parking lot. Do not block entrance, stairs or turnaround.
- Narrow parts of El Toyonal. Do not park so that another car needs to cross the center line in order to get around.

- Country Club Plaza Parking Lots
